



2018 Non-Resident Moose Draw

Important Facts:

- A non-resident Moose hunter may acquire a licence by either of the following methods:
 1. **Through a designated outfitter or guide who has received a licence via the Non-Resident Moose Licence Draw for qualified Outfitters and Guides, or**
 2. **By entering and being successful in the computerized random access draw.**
- All non-resident hunters are required to hunt with a licenced guide.
- Moose Licences, licence fees, application fees and draw numbers, are not transferable or refundable.
- Applicants must be 18 years of age or older at the time of application, have their principal place of residence outside the Province of New Brunswick and must not have had their hunting privileges revoked under the authority of the New Brunswick *Fish and Wildlife Act*.
- Moose Licences are valid in only **one** Wildlife Management Zone. At the time of licence pick-up, non-resident hunters must specify the zone in which they will hunt. Your outfitter or guide may assist you with your choice.
- A 2018 Moose Licence is valid to harvest one moose of either sex during the open season.

DRAW APPLICATIONS ARE ACCEPTED FROM FEBRUARY 5 TO APRIL 30, 2018

NOTE: A non-refundable application fee of \$41.68 (\$26.25 plus a \$10.00 Conservation Fee and applicable tax) Canadian Funds will be charged to your credit card. **ONLY ONE APPLICATION MAY BE MADE PER PERSON.**

You will need a New Brunswick Outdoors Card number in order to apply to the Non-Resident Moose draw. You can register on-line @ www.gnb.ca/naturalresources, click 'Fish & Wildlife Licensing' and register at no cost. You will get your Outdoors Card number instantly and the card will come in the mail within 2 weeks.

TO FIND OUT IF YOU ARE SUCCESSFUL IN THE DRAW YOU MUST CHECK THE WEBSITE BETWEEN MAY 14 AND JUNE 8, 2018

Remember: All licences not purchased by June 8, 2018 will be re-offered to other non-resident hunters

If you are successful in the draw, you have until June 8, 2018 to purchase your licence by calling the telephone number that will be provided to successful applicants upon checking their results on the website (\$630.20 CDN tax included, by credit card). The Fish and Wildlife Branch will contact you in August regarding the procedure to obtain your licence. Energy and Resource Development has very specific Hunter Education Requirements. All hunters are required to meet these requirements prior to the issuance of a hunting licence.
